What is Imara.Education?



An AI-supported education platform for school-age learners in Africa.

Imara brings learning activities and teacher tools together with parent communication and school oversight.

Designed for learning at school and beyond the classroom.



The problems Imara addresses



Unequal access

Distance, connectivity and limited resources can interrupt a child's education.

Limited learning support

Students need explanations and practice beyond the time available in class.

Teacher workload

Preparing assignments and following each learner's progress takes time.

Fragmented information

Parents and school leaders need a clearer view of attendance and learning.

The learning experience



01

A lesson or book page

Learning begins with the material a student is studying.

02

Questions and practice

AI-supported activities turn the material into opportunities to practise.

03

Explanations and feedback

Learners receive support as they work through prepared content.

04

Progress over time

Activity and completion records help educators understand participation.

Teachers remain central to the learning experience.

Who the platform supports



Students

Assignments, question practice, explanations and personal progress.

Teachers

Lesson activities, attendance and a clearer view of student participation.

Parents

School messages, announcements and updates on their child's progress.

Schools and education teams

Timetables, communication and dashboards for attendance and adoption.

Learning without internet

Students can continue learning fully offline using prepared content on the device.

Available offline

Prepared lessons and explanations.
Question activities built from stored AI-prepared content.
Continued practice without a live connection.

When connected

Content updates, messages and central reporting use a connection.
